TAKS Tips for Parents:

Sleep Tight: A good night's sleep is essential. Have students turn off electronics 30 minutes before bedtime to help them get to sleep right away. Eliminating afternoon caffeine intake helps too!

Eat Right: A balanced breakfast eaten slowly is the best way to start the day, and it helps with energy levels until lunch time.
