Yearbook sent flyers and reminders out about the ads last week and another will be sent this week as a final reminder for those who have not submitted their ad to submit. If people forget or do not submit their ads before we submit those pages are we going to refund their money?

The last two years we have not sold the number of yearbooks that have been ordered so we have changed the contracted amount to 250 from 270 books. This number does not change the price per book on our end. Balfour does send a 'buffer' amount when they send our ordered books, but we will not know what that amount is until we receive the books. If we do not sell those buffer books we send them back at no charge.

Ashley and I are putting new flyers up around the school to do another large push to sell year-books. We will also be sending more flyers home. At our meeting Thursday, January 30th with our Balfour rep, Kathi, over half of the yearbook pages were submitted! We have our next meeting set with Kathi for February 18th.
