Had a teacher / volunteer preview night with raffles. ● Family Night was a success - our total sales for the event was approx \$2000. We also raised approx \$150 for All for Books during the event. Absolutely need to have future book fairs with events. ● eWallet: \$441.74 - VERY Successful! ● Online Shopping: \$18.98 Need to push this more. ● All for Books: raised \$396.17 - split amongst 5 teachers (Kellogg, Kreinhop, Riggsby, Nunez, and Saeger) as well as additional books for the library ● Total Fair Sales: \$11,717.47 ● Scholastic Dollars Spent During Fair: \$463.59 for teacher bonuses, volunteers, and books ● Profit: Cash for



the PTO \$2929.37 • Bonuses: 15% Scholastic Dollars Multiple Fairs Award, \$50 SD for attending workshop, plus \$250 SD Early Booking Award = \$2057.92 SD • Dr Hemenway has requested that we consult with Mrs Poronsky and Mrs Morgan in regards to spending our Scholastic Dollars. They overwhelmingly want us to continue to purchase more books for the classrooms. We are able to purchase one complete set of "bruised books" for every classroom teacher. Our new box tops volunteer and coordinator for the next school year, Swogie Urso and I finished counting box tops for the spring contest today!
